OFFICIAL RULES

Participants must be in grades K-12 and must be an active member of the Stamford JCC, currently enrolled in a Stamford JCC class or program, or a Stamford JCC staff member.

We allow only one entry per person. K-4th grade entries will be cropped to **8x10-inches** when framed. 5th-12th grade entries can be no larger than **16x20-inches or 20x16-inches** and must be **capable of being hung on wire**. Entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form that is signed by the entrant's parent/guardian.

By signing, parents grant permission for their children's artwork and first name to be reproduced on stationery and/or notecards to be used by the Stamford JCC and to be shared on social media or in printed materials for marketing purposes only.

Artwork and completed & signed entry form must be received by the JCC by **Tuesday, October 28, 2025, at 5 p.m.**

All entries must be the entrant's original, unpublished, and previously unproduced work. If the Stamford JCC is notified that any element of an entrant's entry infringes upon the rights of another person, the entry will be disqualified from the contest.

At the end of the submission period, The Stamford JCC's official panel of judges will select a first-, second-, and third-place winner from each of 3 divisions – K-4th Grades, 5th-8th Grades, and High School. After the artwork is on display, fans can vote on-site for their favorite.

First-place winners will receive prizes and have their art featured on stationery and/or notecards to be used by the Stamford JCC. Second-place, third-place and fan favorites will also be awarded and **MAY** be featured on stationery and/or notecards to be used by the Stamford JCC (at the JCC's discretion).

This contest is void where prohibited.

By participating in the contest, each entrant grants The Stamford JCC the right to use such entrant's name and artwork in all media for marketing and promotional purposes, as well as on the website or in social media.

Any submission that is considered by The Stamford JCC at its sole and absolute discretion to be objectionable, in whole or in part, will be disqualified and will not be eligible for entry. Except as otherwise stated in these Official Rules, personal information collected online in connection with this contest will be used in accordance with U.S. Kids privacy practices and with the consent given by entrants' parents or guardians at the time of entry. The Stamford JCC shall have no liability for any submission that is lost, intercepted, or not received by The Stamford JCC for any reason.
