Behavior and Discipline

Disciplinary issues are brought to the attention of the KidsPlace Coordinator by the staff. It is at the sole discretion of the KidsPlace Coordinator to handle disciplinary matters with developmentally appropriate methods. These include:

- Positive guidance - When disputes arise among children or between a child and staff, the staff will encourage a “talking out” process, where the goal is to acknowledge feelings and find solutions using the children’s ideas wherever possible.
- Setting clear limits - Staff will encourage and model positive behavior, positive reinforcement, the use of peer support and clearly-defined rules.
- Redirection - A child who may be aggressive or who is disruptive or destructive of other children’s work may be asked to make an activity choice in another area.

Our staff continuously supervises children during any disciplinary actions. Our staff will not be abusive, neglectful, or use corporal, humiliating or frightening punishment under any circumstances. No child will be physically restrained unless it is necessary to protect the safety or health of the child or others, using the least restrictive methods possible, as appropriate.

- All KidsPlace participants must have JCC family membership that is current and in good standing.

KIDSPPLACE FINANCIAL POLICIES

- I. KidsPlace is offered as a full-month program with a minimum enrollment of two (2) months.
- II. Fees are for full-month participation and will not be prorated.
- III. At no time will any payments made toward KidsPlace be refunded. This includes lost program time due to any possible closure of KidsPlace and/or the JCC that may become necessary in order to comply with best-practice policies related to health and safety. Further, all payments made to KidsPlace are non-transferable and cannot be applied to JCC membership or to any other program within the JCC.
- IV. Discount: A Sibling Discount of \$10 per month is applied to all siblings except the first child in the family, for the period of time that all are enrolled in KidsPlace. This discount is based on and applied to KidsPlace Program Fees only.
- V. Registration in the program will renew automatically after the initial two- (2-) month enrollment, and automatic billing will continue through the remainder of the program year, until or unless a parent's written request to terminate the registration is received with a minimum of one month's notice: ie., to withdraw a child after the initial two-month enrollment period, written notification must be received by the KidsPlace office not less than 30 days prior to the child's withdrawal date; otherwise, the child's registration will remain active and automatic monthly billing will proceed.
- VI. If a parent withdraws a child from the program, the child's place will not be held, but rather he/she must reapply in order to rejoin the program, as space permits.
- VII. Deposit and Payment Schedule:
 - > A deposit in an amount equal to one month's program fee is payable at the time of registration.
 - > Monthly fees beyond the deposit will be billed on a monthly basis via automatic charges to the designated credit card. Installments will be processed on the 28th of each month, continuously until or unless the child withdraws from the program as described above in section V.
